### *Application Details*

This scholarship is open to students of all ages. To be considered, students need a Learning Ability Evaluation (LAE) from a Lindamood-Bell Learning Center obtained within the last 12 months (March 2021-April 2022).

Recipients will be announced in late August 2022. Scholarships can be redeemed for instruction scheduled from September 2022 to May 2023. For students in the Southern Hemisphere, scholarships can be redeemed for instruction scheduled from September 2022 until November 2022 and from February 2023 through November 2023.

Scholarship awards will be based upon several factors, including financial need, student learning needs, and availability of funds. Instruction may be provided online or in-person at a Lindamood-Bell Learning Center. All applicants will be notified in writing about the outcome. Scholarships cannot be redeemed for cash. Scholarship awards expire on May 30th, 2023.
